I cannot believe another year has passed! My mother always said that the older you get the faster time flies by. And was she ever correct! We just finished our 25<sup>th</sup> year of operation. A wonderful gift was given to this community when volunteers from St. Malachi Church purchased and renovated this Center, and then helped to keep it open all of these many years. Thanks to you all!

We ended this year with a goodbye to our good friend and wonderful Board President, Jeanette Shemo. Jeanette was an excellent leader and helped guide us through some difficult times—and was able to celebrate many good times as well. To her, goes a huge Thank You! Not to worry though, we did not let her get far—she is now the Board Treasurer.

We welcome into the position of Board President a long-time member and dedicated supporter of St. Malachi Center, Steve Switaj. Steve has been on St. Malachi Center's board since 1999. He is the Chief Financial Officer at Three D Metals. Steve brings a wealth of knowledge and a true love for St. Malachi Center. I know he will help lead us through whatever challenges lie ahead. Steve is a wonderful person, and I truly look forward to our time ahead together.

Our decision to focus on core services has definitely paid off for St. Malachi Center. Our Shower Program and After School Program are stronger than ever. Last year we provided 5,678 showers to homeless men and women. We expanded our service to include a Nurse Clinic & Mental Health Services one morning each week, and strengthened our work with Care Alliance Outreach Services. We also entered into collaboration with St. Malachi Church and a fairly new agency called the Metanoia Project. All of these partnerships have allowed us to be a part of getting the homeless off the street and into permanent housing. That is what our Shower Program should be doing, and I am very proud of our accomplishments in this area.

Our After School Program continues to do excellent work with the children from our neighborhood. The Reading Buddy Program remains a mainstay of our work with children. We see the results over time with children who are so far behind academically. Last year we invested in curriculum and staff training to help our children develop social skills which are sorely lacking in many we serve. We installed "Peaceful Playgrounds" in our parking lot and purchased "Stop, Think, Do". Each child now participates in "friendship club" where they learn to settle disagreements. This coming year, we plan to focus on parenting skills. Parents who learn good parenting skills will certainly impact their children in a positive manner.

I could never end without a strong shout-out to all of our volunteers! You make us tick. Without volunteers working to help with Reading Buddies, Homework, Clothing Ministry, Family Nights, and Fundraisers, we could not exist. You are what keeps our wheels turning. Saying thank you is never enough, but that is all I know how to say.

*St. Malachi Center (SMC) is a family and community resource center. SMC was founded in 1985 to extend the outreach of the 140-year-old St. Malachi Church through formal programs and services. Since that time, SMC has been serving its surrounding Old Angle and Ohio City neighborhoods, a community historically living below the poverty level. Early programs included tutoring for youth, services for the homeless, and meals for families. The same type of programming continues to this day.*

## Adult Programs

**Shower Program:** The Shower Program has grown over the past year with additional services offered, including a nurse clinic, mental health clinic and a joint program with the Metanoia Project to provide needed services such as overnight stays during the winter months and assistance to prepare for permanent housing. **In the past year, SMC provided 5,678 showers.** SMC provides clothes washing three times per week and provides bus tickets for medical and benefits appointments as additional and essential services. **Last winter, 12 homeless individuals were placed in permanent housing as a result of the collaboration between SMC and Metanoia.** The Shower Program has responded well to the needs that homeless men and women bring to St. Malachi Center when they arrive each morning to clean their bodies. Those men and women find a comfortable atmosphere where they are encouraged to talk about themselves and their needs as well as sports, current events and whatever is happening around them. SMC has added needed services over time that address the basic human need to feel accepted and worthwhile.

**Sewing with Friends:** Adults gather weekly to learn the basics of sewing and share a meal. Sewing machines, fabric and patterns are provided.

**Soup & God:** This twice-monthly program is for men in transition to meet over lunch and discuss the blessings and obstacles in their lives.

**Health Clinic:** SMC hosts two health clinics for adults without access to health care services. Three times a month (Monday evenings) there is a free clinic staffed by registered nurses, nurse practitioners, and doctors who volunteer their time. One morning per week there is a free health clinic staffed by a Care Alliance nurse.

**Additional Adult Services:** SMC services to adults include referrals to shelters, mental health providers, housing programs, meal programs, housing assistance and substance abuse programs; assistance with income tax preparation, assistance securing birth certificates, legal identification and furniture; and hosting 12-step meetings.

## Children's Programs



**After School Program:** Forty-three students in K-8 enrolled in the After School Program (ASP) and Youth Club (YC) during the 2010-11 school year. Our Reading Buddies once again worked one-on-one with students in grades K-3 one hour each week to review literacy concepts. Students also participated in literacy programming that included peer tutoring, computer time, and literacy lab. Students were pre- and post-tested to determine effectiveness of the literacy programming. **The**

**results of testing showed a 58% increase in at least one of the Dynamic Indicators of Basic Early Literacy Skills.**

To help youth build appropriate social skills, 43 students participated in Stop, Think, Do curriculum. Students engaged in 10 weeks of the social skills program which included getting to know people's similarities and differences, identifying and communicating feelings and problem-solving. Students maintained weekly behavior and attendance charts to evaluate results. A review of all participants shows that 42% maintained or showed improvement on their behavior charts. Stop, Think, Do has become a standard part of the Center's curriculum.



Students in Youth Club had an opportunity to impact their community through volunteering and field trips. Six students, grades 6-8, were enrolled in the program. **Students participated in 4 field trips and completed 357 hours of service, which included 333 hours of peer tutoring and 24 hours of planning and implementation of a Field Day for the younger children.**

In May, the Center hosted its first **Safety Town**. Thirty children attended with parents or older siblings. They saw a video on gun safety, practiced crossing the street and learned about bike safety. The event ended with hamburgers and hot dogs. Special thanks to Commander Sulzer of the 2nd District for his help. We hope to make Safety Town an annual event.

**Summer Camp:** Fifty children enrolled in this year's Summer Camp, which focused on swimming skills & literacy. **Thirty-four children in grades 1-5 completed swim lessons and 99% advanced at least 1 level.** They also took part in important water safety skills classes. O\*H\*I\*O Masters Swim Club provided goggles and medals for the program.

# Family Programs

**Family Activity Night:** Family Activity Night attendance is growing monthly. Families share dinner and participate in a variety of activities designed to engage them as a family unit. Family art projects, cookie decorating and our popular Trunk-or-Treat Halloween event provide families with a fun and safe outlet to spend time with one another.

**Clothing Ministry:** Every third Saturday, clothing and small household items are distributed to families in need.

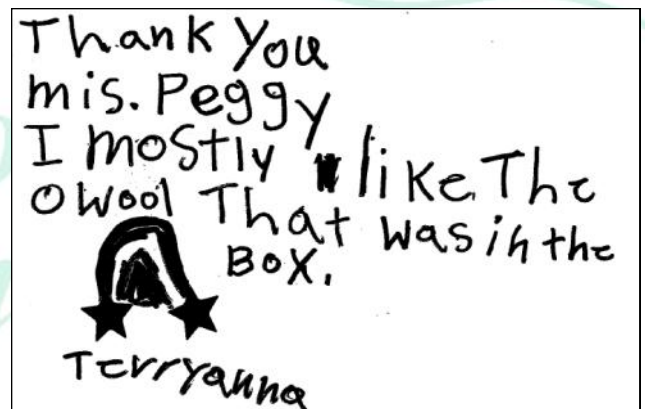

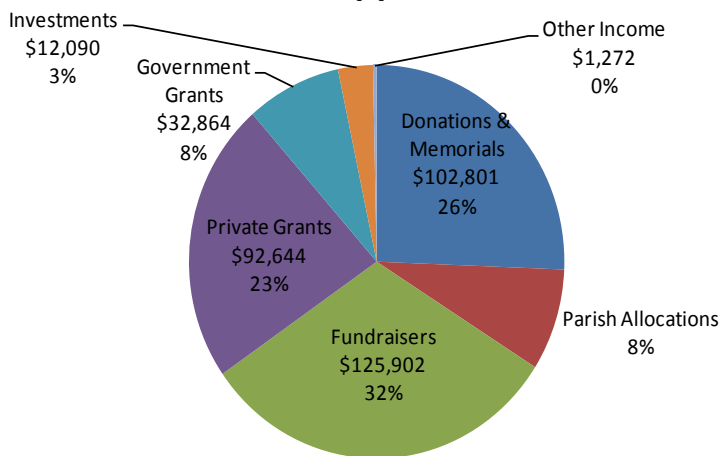

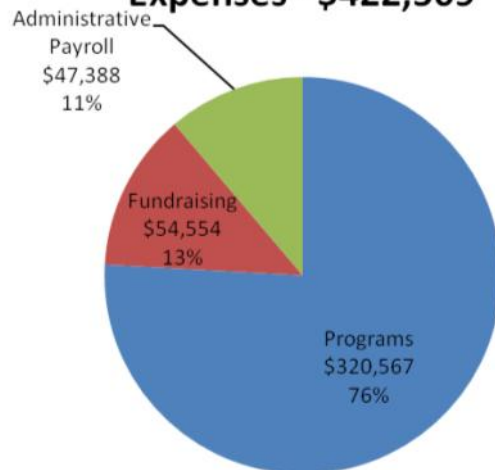
